Practise

When you watch the lessons be active and take notes. At the end of the lesson, organise your notes (word families / synonyms etc) in a way that suits your learning style. Part of the learning process is interacting with the new words and grammar.

Tip
Building "word families"
means you are working with
words in a meaningful way
which will give you a better
understanding of how they
can be used in different
situations.

- Learn vocabulary in context, remember that we do not communicate with individual words, but sentences and phrases.
- Personalise -make it relevant to you. The activities in the lessons will guide you to use language to express your own ideas, feelings, preferences and opinions. Personalisation is key since it involves true communication -real information about yourself.
- Use the extra material included in the courses to review and recycle. Written by expert teachers these are valuable practice
 - opportunities. Research has shown that we need to meet a word at least 7 times before we know it properly. Repetition will reinforce the language and help you to retain new words and grammar.

Tip

It is unrealistic and not useful to try to memorise lists of isolated words. When faced with new words, choose the ones that are relevant to you and you think you will realistically need. Then write example sentences in a context you might use.



Participate

Try to use a new word or expressions the next time you are in a lesson or speaking to a friend or colleague in English.

Tip Make the most of your resources. If you have contact with native speakers, then ask them to correct you if you make a mistake

- Vocabulary so that it becomes an active part of your language remember we have lots of ways for you to participate....!

 Speaking Groups, Open Classes, Masterclasses, Writing Club explore the different options and find what works best for you!
- Join in, take part and have fun -if you are enjoying yourself and having fun then you will want to learn and you will stay motivated.
